Below are the activities and events we have hosted and are hosting over the end of term one. We kindly ask for your support, however big or small, so that we can spread a little joy and make a difference to families in need.

Children in Need and the Great British Book Bake-off

On Monday 18th November, we organised a staff bake-off. Staff baked a cake in the theme of a book and brought it in to be judged by a pupil panel. Mrs Phillips, our Food Technician won with her impressive 'Three Little Pigs' cake. All of the cakes were then sold at breaktime to raise funds for Children in Need. **We raised £50.00**.

Toy Collection

The Salvation Army have launched their annual Toy Appeal and partnered with schools who will support them by helping to distribute toys to families in need this December.

Foodbank

We are organising 'essential item' hampers containing food items (tins and packets within date) alongside toiletries such as shower gel, toothpaste and hand soap. If you are able to support us by donating some of these essential items, please hand them to reception by Friday 13th of December.

We're holding our event on Thursday 19th December along with a festive lunch for pupils and staff at a cost of £2.55pp. Pupils and staff are invited to wear a Christmas jumper with their uniform.
