Forthcoming Change of our Management Information System (MIS) and ClassCharts

We would also like to inform you that we have recently changed our Management Information System (MIS) from SIMS to Arbor. This system will enable us to work faster, smarter and more collaboratively with all parents / carers.

Following the Easter break in April 2025, it is our intention to move communication and behaviour information to Arbor and provide parents / carers with a cloud-based portal. The parent portal will make information sharing more easily accessible as we can share live updates about your child. The Arbor parent portal app will replace our current ClassCharts app.
