Breaks and Lunchtime

During transition days pupils will pay for food using their biometric finger (a ParentMail registration link will be emailed to you) if you don't have this, please supply your child **with cash**.

Free porridge is available for all pupils at breaktime.

If your child receives free school meals at primary school, this will be the case at Longfield, including during the transition days. Your child just needs to say their name at the till, and this will be taken care of. Alternatively, pupils can choose to bring a packed lunch.

In September, pupils will use the fingerprint system where balances can be paid online via ParentMail or they can top up using the top-up machines.

There is a range of positive play equipment available for pupils to play with at break and lunchtime.

If your child needs the toilet they are to queue up at the stage where they will be directed to the toilets. Children are not expected to go to the toilet during lessons.

Examples of how much the following will cost you:

1) Breaktime - bacon sandwich and milkshake = £1.90 Lunch - a baguette with traybake and a 250ml bottle of water = £3.30

2) Breaktime - Porridge = Free Lunch - pasta pot with a biscuit and Radnor fruit drink = £3.40

3) Breaktime - Porridge = Free Lunch - a jacket potato with a cake, pudding or fruit and Radnor fruit = £2.55

Expectations for September

- Arrive to school by 8.25am you must be in form by 8:25am
- Arrive to school in the correct uniform

Equipment



In September, each pupil will be supplied with:

Medical Needs and Care Plans

Attendance

- Not only is attendance at school a legal requirement, it is vitally important to a pupil's education. How can pupils be expected to learn and pass examinations if they have not been present when topics have been taught?
- National research with Year 11 pupils confirms this underperformance. Those pupils with 85% attendance or less are likely to underachieve in each subject by one full grade. Pupils with attendance in excess of 95% perform as predicted
- Children with over 90% attendance are more likely to gain 5 or more grade 9-4 GCSEs or any qualifications
- 96% attendance or above is our target!

Rewards and Behaviour

- Green clicks and Star Student: these are positive award points which pupils can accumulate to be awarded prizes and opportunities
- Rewards trips are held throughout the year
- Behaviour is monitored through the 'Choices' system. Children are expected to make the right behaviour choice
- If pupils choose incorrectly, they will spend time in the choices room where a wide variety of support and intervention is available to assist in regulating their behaviour.
