Dear Parent / Carer,

**Re: Year 11 Exams and Wraparound Revision (Ref: 0090-25ASW)**

As we progress through the examination period, I would like to add some clarity to the wrap around situation for Year 11 pupils.

Pupils have started the exam process extremely well and we are very proud of their mature attitude at this significant time of their lives. To support their developing maturity and prepare them for the next part of their educational journey, we will be making bespoke adjustments to their weekly timetables. This will enable them to maximise their time as certain examination subjects conclude.

We have made significant adjustments to the entire school day to best support Year 11 pupils and to maximise the specialist provision we can provide onsite to enable your child to gain specialist intervention.

The wrap around plan shows when the exams are taking place. If your child does not have an exam on a particular day, morning or afternoon - we will provide lessons to support revision, based on the following days exam. However, on some occasions, it may be more beneficial for them to revise from home.

Where the overview indicates a specific intervention time, we will ensure that provision is provided by specialist teachers to support that subject.

Where the timetable indicates 'normal lesson', pupils will attend their normal timetabled lesson where they will be expected to complete work with a subject specialist as this subject has not yet concluded.

Yellow sessions indicate that this subject is concluded, and pupils can choose to revise either **in school or at home**. This will be determined by the child's ability to get home within a given time period, **and on the understanding that they must return to school in time for any scheduled intervention, subject lessons or exams later in the day.**

**concluded, but P4 is a maths lesson, and they still have an exam to sit, they MUST return for P4.**

Red sessions indicate periods when home study is expected, providing parents / carers have given consent.

**Pupils will only be allowed home if you have completed the consent form. To provide consent, please click here to complete this short forms.** Alternatively, pupils will go to their regular classroom, for example, art. Here they will be supervised by a non-specialist whilst they complete independent study for upcoming exams.

### **Week commencing Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026**

This bespoke plan will commence immediately following half-term. All Year 11 pupils are expected in school for the full day on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026 and they will be given their personalised timetable (as per the example on page 3). We will also add 'Intervention', 'Optional Home or School Study' and 'Home Study' to Year 11 Arbor timetables meaning their correct timetable will appear in the **pupil and parent portal by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2026. Please ensure your child has accessed their pupil portal.**

We kindly ask that you check your child's personalised timetable weekly to ensure you and they are clear on when they are expected in school and when we agree they can work at home, provided consent has been given.
